Purpose

To provide participants with the opportunity to create an original, highly improbable, humorous story.

To provide an opportunity to learn by observing more proficient speakers who have benefited from their Toastmasters training.

Tall Tales Extravaganza Rules

ELIGIBILITY: - The member must be in good standing, from a club in good standing

ORIGINAL: - The speech should be substantially original, highly exaggerated, of an improbable nature and have a theme or a plot. Humour and props may be added to support the speech

SPEAKING ORDER: - The contestants will draw for their position

TIMING: - 5 to 7 minutes; less than 4 minutes and 30 seconds or more than 7 minutes and 30 seconds will result in disqualification

SPEAKING AREA: - The whole area may be used at the speaker's discretion.

PROTESTS AND DISQUALIFICATIONS: - Limited to contestants and judges. Must be lodged to the Chief Judge and/or Contest Chair PRIOR to the announcement of the winners. A contestant can be disqualified on the basis of originality, as determined by the majority of the judges. All decisions by the judges are final

PUBLICITY: - Contestants must agree to be filmed and/or photographed to be used by the contest host as a promotional tool on Toastmasters web sites or Youtube.com

CONSTRAINTS: - Time constraints allow for a maximum of 10 contestants. Should there be more than 10 competitors, the first to notify the contact names will have priority.
