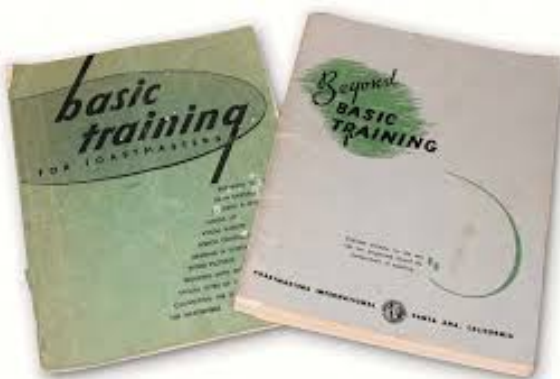


The club met Mondays at 6:15 at the Y.M.C.A.
